RFMP Status Update (August 28 – September 18)

Since the TAC generally serves as a forum to update interested parties in the San Joaquin County on the status of the RFMP, a brief overview of the action items completed in the past few weeks is presented herein for those who may be interested in lieu of the September TAC meeting.

Progress Completed

Over the past few weeks, the RFMP team focused on incorporating input and feedback received from RFMP stakeholders into the Regional Settings and Assessment of Flood Hazards chapters of the RFMP. Additionally, the RFMP team has discussed giving presentations to the City of Stockton and San Joaquin County on the RFMP effort and Senate Bill 5 and Urban Level of Protection criteria. Additionally, Emergency Response interviews have continued with SJ OES and other ER staff in the Regions. Finally, a meeting with DWR's FESSRO and Conservation Strategy team, NGOs, and other RFMP Stakeholders is currently in the process of being scheduled. The purpose of this meeting will be to have the RFMP team understand what information DWR has on how the FESSRO & CS efforts may relate to Paradise Cut. Anticipated Action Items in the Next Couple Months

The RFMP team anticipates releasing the Draft Introduction, Regional Settings, and Assessment of Flood Hazards chapters of the RFMP in October, once information from all the RD's in the Regions has been compiled.

The second inter-regional coordination meeting will be held on October 1 with the Lower SJ, Mid SJ, and Upper SJ regions. In addition to this meeting, the RFMP Team is hopeful to have a meeting with DWR FESSRO and Conservation Strategy team members in late October. An invite has been sent to DWR staff, but are still awaiting responses.

Finally, a meeting to discuss the RFMP, SB5 and ULOP with the City of Stockton Community Development staff, and a possible follow-up City Council presentation are anticipated in October.

Information Needed

The RFMP team has compiled extensive information thus far; however, we are still awaiting some additional information. One of the key pieces of information which is needed to inform the Assessment of Flood Hazards is the updated CVFED Hydraulic Models DWR is preparing. Based on conversations with DWR, we expect to have these models by the second week in October. In addition to this data, our RFMP team needs the ULE data to better understand geotechnical deficiencies in the Region. Both of these pieces of information are key to completing the Assessment of Flood Hazards chapter.
