SUBJECT: AMENDING RESOLUTION 23-31 TO ADD A REGULAR MEETING

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Directors of the San Joaquin Area Flood Control Agency amend resolution 23-31 to add a regular meeting to the 2024 regular meeting schedule.

SUMMARY

Under SJAFCA's Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement executed in May 1995, meetings shall be called and held in the manner provided by 54950 et seq. of the Government Code. Section 54954 provides that "Each legislative body of a local agency, except for advisory committees or standing committees, shall provide, by ordinance, resolution, bylaws, or by whatever other rule is required for the conduct of business by that body, the time and place for holding regular meetings." On November 16, 2023 the Board adopted Resolution 23-31 setting the regular meetings for the year.

DISCUSSION

There is now a need for a regular meeting of the Board on December 12, 2024. In order to designate that meeting as a regular meeting of the Board, the Board of Directors needs to amend Resolution 23-31 to include the December 12, 2024 meeting.
