AQUATIC VEGETATION CONTROL PROGRAM IN FIVE MILE SLOUGH

This notice is to inform you that the San Joaquin Area Flood Control Agency (Agency) will be utilizing aquatic herbicides and or algaecides to control the nuisance growth of aquatic vegetation within the Five Mile Slough in compliance with an approved Aquatic Pesticide Application Plan by the State of California Water Resources Control Board.

All herbicide and or algaecide applications will follow the provisions of Water Quality Order No. 2013-0002-DWQ, Statewide General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CAG990005, adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board. The aquatic herbicides and or algaecides are registered with the California Department of Pesticide Regulation and their use will be monitored and in compliance with all regulations and restrictions as set forth by the regulatory agencies.
