**CONDITIONAL LETTER OF MAP REVISION FOR SMITH CANAL CLOSURE  
DEVICE, CITY OF STOCKTON, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

The San Joaquin Area Flood Control Agency, and Reclamation Districts 1614 and 828 are providing for your review and endorsement, the attached preliminary documentation for the Smith Canal Conditional Letter of Map Revision.
