The Atherton Cove Association, represented by this office, objects to your application for and anticipated receipt of \$22,309,666 in public funds from the State Department of Water Resources for the construction of the Smith Canal Gate. Your application and proposed acceptance of the funds, for so specific a purpose, is a "project" under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). See Public Resources Code section 21065 and 14 Cal. Code Regs. section 15378(a); *Save Tara v. City of West Hollywood* (2008) 45 Cal.4th 116, 140-142. The potentially significant adverse effects of this project – a 700-foot-long dam built on the bed of the San Joaquin River – are obvious. There is no evidence you have complied with CEOA.
